The procedure will be performed using local anesthesia. There are usually no restrictions after the procedure concerning driving or returning to work. However, if oral sedation will be utilized as an adjunct, you will need someone to escort you to and from our office and you should not return to work for the remainder of the day.

- All patients under the age of 18 must be accompanied on each visit by their parent or legal guardian.
- Please bring your referral information from your restorative dentist.
- Eat breakfast or lunch before your appointment to ensure a normal blood glucose level.
- Continue all routine medication for blood pressure, diabetes, thyroid problems, and any other conditions as recommended by your physician. However, do not take medication for discomfort (i.e. ibuprofen, Advil, Motrin, Aleve, etc.) prior to the first visit because it may mask symptoms and hinder diagnosis.
- If you require prophylactic antibiotics before dental visit for a prosthetic heart valve or orthopedic prosthesis (artificial hip, knee, elbow, etc), please call our office for instructions. If you've already discussed this with us, you do not need to call again.
- Please let us know if you take Coumadin (warfarin sodium) so we can contact your physician in advance to receive your current INR readings.
- Insurance: Endodontic fees are based on the complexity of the procedures. We will make every effort to help you get reimbursed by your insurance carrier. Payment is due at the time of service. We welcome any questions you may have about payments and insurance benefits.
